Instructions

1. The Lightstar LS-575PE HMI 575 Watt kit is a compact, dual power, PAR light with multi-use 575/1200 Watt ballast. The fixture uses 575w 120v G22 socket metal halide lamps.

Safety Precautions

- 1. The 575 Watt fixture has been designed for professional use and must be operated by qualified personnel only.
- 2. Electrical Connections: Do not attach the ballast directly to any electrical mains. The ballast has the proper three pin grounded plug that works with a standard AC socket.
- 3. The 575 Watt fixture can only be used with the Lightstar 575 Watt/1200 Watt electronic ballast.

Working Conditions

- The best working position max tilting is 90° from horizontal.
- Ambient temperature usage +/- 45° C (113°F) Max Limit.
- Minimum distance in which the fixture can be to inflammable objects is 2 feet along any side.
- Do not cover the ventilation holes on the fixture housing. They are necessary for proper ventilation.
- Use only original parts and accessories from Lightstar.
- Before hanging the fixture, make sure the suspension points are properly rated to handle the weight of the fixture.
- It is always advisable to add a safety cable or chain through the yoke to properly suspend the fixture in place.

Warning: DO NOT USE THE LS-575TE IN A SPACE WITH FLAMMABLE SUBSTANCES.

WARNING: UV Risk / Health Risk. The lamps that are used with the LS-575TE emit an amount of UV Radition which can be dangerous to human health if not properly shielded against.

THE FIXTURE MUST NEVER BE USED IN SITUATION WHEN DIRECT LIGHT EMISSIONS FROM THE LAMP CAN OCCUR. (Ex: no front glass, no internal mirror, damaged front housing).

Accessories Use

A 5-Lens set for changing the beam angle of the light from flood to spot.

Lenses included with the kit:

- 1. Spot 9° Beam Angle
- 2. Narrow Flood 11°-22° Beam Angle
- 3. Flood 21°-42° Beam Angle
- 4. Super Flood 42° Beam Angle
- 5. Frost 35° Beam Angle

(Lens Size 195mm / 7.6")

Lens can be inserted in front of the fixture to change the desired beam angle.

WARNING: LENS CAN BECOME VERY HOT AFTER PROLONGED USE IN THE FIXTURE. THERMAL GLOVES ARE RECOMMENDED FOR WORKING WITH THE FIXTURE OR REMOVING THE LENS.

Installation Instructions

Connecting the fixture to the ballast and energizing the ballast with power.

- 1. The ballast and the fixture are compatible Lightstar products.
- 2. The ballast is appropriate for the AC power that will energize the ballast and fixture. (Voltage & Frequency)
- 3. The ballast is properly grounded and the main power switch is in the OFF position.
- 4. The Lamp is fitted into the fixture.
 - a) The lamp is the proper wattage for the fixture.
 - b) There is nominal power equal to the ballast.
 - c) The AC power is not higher than the max power of the ballast.
- 5. The safety glass shield is in good working order with no cracks or anomalies. The safety glass is in the proper position and there is safety wire guard.

WARNING: SHIELD GLASS WILL NEED TO BE CHANGED IF THEY HAVE BECOME VISIBLY DAMAGED TO SUCH AN EXTENT THAT THEY ARE NO LONGER EFFECTIVE. (Ex: The fixture has racks in the glass, or deep scratches).

Lamp Installation & Replacement

A) A user needs to ensure the fixture is disconnected from the main power supply.

WARNING! Wait at least 5 minutes from switching off the fixture to open the protection shield. This will avoid risk of injury from a lamp explosion.

WARNING!! Lamp will still be HOT to the touch even after the alloted lamp rest period. Thermal gloves are recommended for working with the fixture and bulb.


- B) The user should check to see that the new lamp is the correct wattage.
- C) The user will release the lamp clamp lever inside the front of the fixture.
- D) To replace the lamp pull up and out to remove the old lamp.
- 1) Re-lamp procedures: Do not touch the bulb with your bare-hands this can cause oil to accumulate on the grass and reduce the performance of the lamp life. The plastic/foam cover which protects the lamp should not be removed until after the lamp is fitted into the fixture. If bulb becomes dirty due to hand contact or from any contaminant, it can be cleaned with a cloth moisten with alcohol.
- E) Re-tighten the lamp clamping device.
- F) Close the lens door and securely latch.

NOTE: Other lamps may be used as long as the meet the technical specs of the LS-575PE)

Periodic Fixture Inspection

- 1. The condition of the internal wiring and ceramic base will need to be inspected and tested every 4000 working hours or at least once a year. This frequency may need to be increased if the fixture has endured rough treatment. All internal components should only be replaced with Lightstar spare parts.
- 2. The lamp should be checked every 100 working hours. The lamp should be changed if the lamp becomes deformed or damaged otherwise explosion might occur. Defer to instruction provided by the lamp manufacture.
- 3. Always check the safety shield before every use.
- 4. All high-voltage components (ex: voltage wires, lamp ceramic, external shield, igniter must be inspected every 100 working hours or at least once a year).
- 5. Outer door hinges and latching system must be checked every 250 working hours to insure proper seating of the safety shield. This will allow inspections of accessories and the holding clamps.
- 6. The condition of the internal mirror must be maintained every 250 working hours. It must be replaced whenever it becomes either cracked or broken. It is essential for the performance of the fixture.
