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


Thanks for purchasing E-IMAGE products.

- 1. Please don't exceed the max. payload of the elevation system.
- 2. Please don't dismantle or modify the equipment.
- 3. Please don't operate the equipment when it is out of order and contact the seller then.
- 4. Please don't use the supplied AC adapter and controller with other equipment.
- 5. Please don't pull or apply force on to the cables.
- 6. Please don't plug or unplug the cables with wet hands.
- 7. Please don't use the equipment in water or excessively humid environments.
- 8. Please lock the tripod leg and quick release plate tightly before elevating the column.
- 9. Please keep the quick release plate locked during use.
- 10. Please don't adjust the height of the column before securely mounting the camera.
- 11. Please lower the column when attaching or removing accessories.
- 12. Please remove the camera from the tripod before transportation.


Installation and Settings

A: Setting the GAM260 Legs

- 1 Take out the GAM260 from the carrying bag of the SC-4.
- * When unpacking, carefully inspect the equipment for any damage and ensure that all accessories are present.
- 2 Loosen the spreader knob of column and open the GAM260 legs to the desired position, then lock in place with the same knob.




Coosen the mono-lock knobs on the three legs, adjust the legs to the desired height, and then tighten the knobs.


B: EI-7004B Dolly


- **1** Before El-7004B's installation, remove the middle spreader by pressing the buttons on both sides to perform a quick release. Also, remove the rubber feet.
- ② Carefully grip the main body of the GAM260 and align the spikes with the grooves on the dolly.
- 3 Once aligned, pull the pad-removing tab to securely attach the feet to the dolly.
- * Avoid placing your hands between the GAM260 legs and the center column to prevent any potential hand injuries while carrying the GAM260.



C: Connecting Power Source / Controller

- Connect one end of the 2,5m column motor cable to the motor cable on the center column and the other end to the M1 output port of the power adapter.
- * An additional 2.5m column motor cable is included for extension, if needed.
- 2 Insert the crystal head of the remote controller into the HS port of the power adapter.
- 3 Connect the AC end of the power adapter to a power source using the provided cable.







Installation and Settings

D: Mounting the PTZ Camera

- Release the locking knob on the P13 QR adapter, press and hold the safety button on the side to remove the camera plate.
- 2 Mount the PTZ camera onto the camera plate using the 3/8" or 1/4" screws provided.
- Press the safety button and slide the PTZ camera attached into the desired position carefully, and then tighten the locking knob.
- Please ensure that the camera is securely fixed and then bundle all cables neatly.





E: Wired Remote Controller Operation

1 Reset operation.

We highly recommend performing a reset operation at the first switch on!

Press and hold the down \odot button to reach lowest position, then release. Continue to press and hold the down \odot button until "RST" appears on the display, then release. Finally, press and hold the down \odot button until the display changes from "RST" to a number.



2 Elevation Setup.

Press the up or down or down button to control the upward or downward movement of the column.

Preset Position Setup.

When the column reaches the desired storage position, press the m button. The digital display will show "S-" and then release. Press the (i), (a), or (a) button to save the memory position.

* Each time a new position is stored, it will overwrite the previous position if there was one.

4 Limit Setup (Up & Down).

Press the up button or down button to reach the desired working height, then release.

Press the m button until the display shows "S-", then release.

Press the up 🛇 button or down 🕑 button until the display flashes once, then release.

Press and hold the m button again for 3 seconds:

When the display shows "999" indicates the upper limit setting is completed. When the display shows "00.0" indicates the lower limit setting is completed.

6 Limit Cancellation.


Press the m button until the display shows "S-", then release. Press and hold the m button again for 3 seconds until the display shows "555".

6 Exception Display Description.

Exception code	Exception description	Symptom	Solution
E01	M1 overcurrent protection	The controller displays E01 and the column stops.	Please reset the cloumn: Press and hold the down ♥ button until "RST" appears on the display, then release.
E07	M1 Hall abnormality	The controller displays E07 and the column stops.	Press and hold the down \bigcirc button again until the display changes from "RST" to a number.
H01	Overheating protection/ Overload protection	The controller displays H01, the column stops, and pressing any key has no effect.	After about 30 minutes of recovery, the controller displays the current height, and it can be used normally, or it can be used normally after the power is turned off for 10 seconds.





Use of Optional Accessories

A: MS-010 Tripod Horizontal Boom

- 1 Attach the MS-010 to the GAM260 with a 3/8" screw through the bottom screw hole.
- Install PTZ cameras on the MS-010 with 1/4" screw provided, allowing for the simultaneous mounting of two PTZ cameras.
- Adjust PTZ camera placement by manipulating the locking knobs on the MS-010 (upright or upside-down).




* Ensure that you adjust the MS-010 to the desired position before installing the PTZ cameras.

After installing the cameras, securely lock them in place to prevent any accidental camera drops.

B: 260AC-01 2.4G Remote Controller


- Connect the crystal head of the 2.4G receiver box to the HS port of the power adapter.
- * If needed, the wired controller can be connected to the receiver box for use.
- For the initial setup, requires pairing. Press the learning button on the 2.4G receiver box first, then press the up and down buttons simultaneously. The indicator light will flash with in 5 seconds, indicating successful pairing.
- * Usually factory-preconfigured already for out-of-the-box use.
- Once paired, use the designated buttons (up, down, or stop) for column's height adjustment until the next button press to stop.


C: 26V V-Mount Battery Available

- Put the EI-A05V on the tripod and make sure to lock it tightly
- 2 Attach the battery adapter on the El-A05V.
- Attach the 26V V-mount battery on the AD-10.
- Connect the included cable correctly.



D: Compatibilty with video heads

- Use an appropriate wrench to remove the P13 QR adapter from the top of the GAM260.
- Securely attach the EI-A19 to the top of the GAM260 using the provided screws tightly.
- Easily mount a 100mm bowl size fluid head and camera when El-A19 is in place.





E: 260AC-02 Controller Clamp

• Rotate the locking knob clockwise to loosen the controller clamp, position it on the pan handle, and then lock it.

Thread the controller wire through the hole on the controller clamp plate, lock the side knobs after the controller placed.

6 Tighten the two screws.





Daily Maintenance

Daily maintenance

Storage and transport:

When not using the head for a long time, please turn all the knobs to the minimum setting. When not using the tripod, please avoid storing it vertically to prevent damage.

When not using the tripod or during transportation, please ensure it is stored in the carry bag.

Function inspection:

Please check the tripod payload and the condition of the head locking regularly to avoid accidents

Please regularly check and adjust the condition of the tripod and head locking to increase the service life.

Function inspection:

- 1. Use a lint-free cloth to clean the tripods regularly.
- 2. Please store it in the carrying case, if not used for a long time.
- 3. Use a semi-stiff brush or a vacuum for cleaning.

Always engage safety locks and devices where applicable on the products.

Don't use the product at temperatures below 10°C or above 40°C. Clean with mild detergent and a soft cloth. Remove dust and sand from all locking threads and sliding segments. Dry the product after use in wet conditions.

IMPORTANT: It is not recommended to use the product in seawater.
